Introduction to Cochrane Systematic Reviews Workshop

Brief Description of Course - Scope

This course introduces participants to basic concepts for conducting systematic reviews of the effectiveness of interventions. The course will provide step-by-step guidance on how to develop and register a systematic review protocol. Participants will also be introduced to the principles of developing a search strategy for their planned systematic reviews. Participants are expected to independently develop a systematic review protocol on a topic of their choice. Parts of the protocol will be completed through homework assignments, in-class presentations and group reviews and feedback.

Brief description of the content

This course presents an overview of the concepts necessary for conducting systematic reviews of the effectiveness of interventions and meta-analyses. The course content provides a step-by-step guidance on how to conduct systematic reviews and meta-analysis in 9 modules, including

- 1. basic concepts of evidence-based healthcare and systematic reviewing
- 2. developing a focused/answerable research question
- 3. defining inclusion/exclusion criteria
- 4. developing a search strategy and perform an essential electronic database search
- 5. data abstraction and management
- 6. planning the meta-analysis and basic statistical methods for meta-analysis
- 7. planning the critical appraisal of a clinical trial or review article
- 8. navigating the Cochrane library
- 9. developing and registering a protocol for a systematic review

Target audience

Academics, Researchers, Persons who are considering authoring a systematic review or who already have a registered systematic review title for which they wish to develop a protocol.
